

Visa for medical treatment

If you are going to Germany to receive medical treatment for duration no longer than 90 days you need to apply for a visa for medical treatment.

The processing of an application for a visa for medical treatment takes approximately **two weeks**. The visa application can be submitted at the earliest **3 months prior** to the planned trip.

Before submitting your application, please prepare **all** of the following documentation. Incomplete documentation may result in the rejection of your application.

You have to submit your application **in person**. All documents need to be presented in the **given order in original**. Should you wish to keep any originals, kindly provide an additional copy.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Valid passport (issued within the last 10 years and valid for at least 3 months after leaving the Schengen area with at last two empty pages).
<input type="checkbox"/>	Valid Tanzanian visa or residence permit (if applicable)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Application form fully completed & visa declaration 1, duly signed (see general information)
<input type="checkbox"/>	One passport size picture , not older than three months with a bright background and frontal view of the face (please do not attach the picture to the application form) Digitally-altered passport pictures will not be accepted
<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy of your passport's data page
<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy of your Tanzanian visa or residence permit (if applicable)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Invitation letter from the hospital or doctors practice not older than 4 weeks and signed , stating the dates of your trip, confirming that all payments for the treatment/chek-up have been made or including an estimate on which costs are to be expected.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of housing e.g. confirmation of the hospital or doctors practice that you stay in their guesthouse OR Hotel booking under your name
<input type="checkbox"/>	If sponsored by host in Germany or if your own funds are not sufficient: Original & copy of Formal Obligation ("Verpflichtungserklärung") from your host
<input type="checkbox"/>	Flight itinerary to Germany and back to Tanzania or final destination , rail ticket or others (NO flight booking)
<input type="checkbox"/>	copy of the valid visa / residence permit of your final destination (if applicable)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of travel health insurance (Tanzanian or German), valid for the entire stay in the Schengen area with a minimum coverage of 30,000.00 EUR, including the following details: name of insured person, length of coverage, insurance sum
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of employment (or letter of business registration, is self-employed) OR enrolment letter from university or school in Tanzania

<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of sufficient funds to cover the costs of your proposed trip: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - last three bank statements with your name, OR - Declaration of non-formal obligation, passport copy as well as last three bank statements of the financial supporter (signature must be certified by a notary public if supporter is not present at the interview) OR - Declaration of formal obligation (Verpflichtungserklärung) by your host
	For minors: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> birth certificate with parental information; original and official translation into German or English (plus one copy) <input type="checkbox"/> consent letter signed by both parents (signature must be certified by a notary public if parent is not present at the interview) <input type="checkbox"/> application form signed by both parents <input type="checkbox"/> passport copies of the parents
<input type="checkbox"/>	visa fee (60,- Euro payable in TSH according to the current exchange rate of the German Embassy in Dar es Salaam)
