Visa to seek vocational training place (Section 17 Residence Act)

Basic information

- Please see basic information on applying for a visa on our website. **Applications can only be submitted via the [Consular Services Portal](#).**
- Tanzanian documents need to be legalised and the documents need to be in the English or German language, otherwise accompanied by a translation.
- The German mission is only competent should you have your permanent residence in Tanzania
- Documents not in the German language must be submitted with a certified German translation. A translation of the personal data page of the passport is, however, not required.
- Certificates, diplomas, etc. must be presented in the original with apostille/legalisation.
- **Processing time is as a rule ca. eight weeks** but can take longer in individual cases.
- Flight reservations are not required to apply for a visa – please only book when you have received your visa.
- The mission abroad reserves the right to request further documents.
- Missing documentation delays the procedure and can result in your application being rejected.
- **Please do not contact the mission abroad to check the status of your application during the normal processing period.** Such inquiries are extremely time-consuming for the visa section and can thus not be answered.

General information

You can enter Germany to look for a vocational training place if your **German language skills** are at B1 level and you are **younger than 35 years old**. You can find out more about living and working in Germany at www.make-it-in-germany.com.

	Proof of German language skills (B1) in the form of a recognised language diploma	
	<p><u>Financing</u> (original and one copy) To stay in Germany, each individual applicant must have at their disposal at least 1.091 € net per month. Proof of these means (for example in the form of a blocked account or a formal undertaking by a third person to cover all costs) is to be provided in advance when the application is submitted. When submitting an application, financial means totalling at least 6.546,- € and additional funding to finance departure from Germany where applicable totalling 7.500,- € must be proven.</p> <p><u>In the case of financing in the form of a blocked account:</u> Open the blocked account in good time BEFORE applying for a visa. When applying for a visa, only the official opening confirmation stating the total amount paid in and the monthly amount available will be accepted. A confirmation without stating these amounts is not sufficient. The deposit or transfer receipt without the bank confirmation is not sufficient.</p>	
	<u>Health insurance</u> in line with EU standards (covering the entire Schengen area, minimum coverage of 30,000 €, valid from the day of entry for a period of six months)
