## Blue Card (EU) Visa tertiary-level qualification

(Section 18g Residence Act)

## **Basic information**

- Please see basic information on applying for a visa on our website.
   Applications can only be submitted via the <u>Consular Services Portal</u>.
- The German mission is only competent should you have your permanent residence in Tanzania
- Documents not in the German language must be submitted with a certified German translation. A
  translation of the personal data page of the passport is, however, not required.
- Certificates, diplomas, etc. must be presented in the original with apostille/legalization.
- The visa must, where applicable, be approved by the Federal Employment Agency and the competent foreigners authority. The visa can only be issued when these approvals have been received.
- Processing time is circa six weeks but can take longer in individual cases.
- Flight reservations are not required to apply for a visa please only book when you have received your visa and refrain from booking before.
- The mission abroad reserves the right to request further documents at all times.
- Missing documentation delays the procedure and can result in your application being rejected.
- Please do not contact the mission abroad to check the status of your application during the normal processing period. Such inquiries are extremely time-consuming for the visa section and can thus not be answered.

## **General information**

To apply for the Blue Card (EU) with tertiary-level qualification in Germany you will need

- a tertiary-level qualification that took at least three years to complete, corresponding to level 6 of either ISCED 2011 or the European Qualifications Framework. Some examples of professions that can be achieved through a tertiary education program are technical specialist, commercial specialist, specialist with a master craftsman's certificate, pedagogical specialist and therapeutic specialist. More information: ISCED 2011
- a contract of employment (at least six months) in Germany corresponding to your qualifications and
- a minimum annual gross salary of EUR 45.300,- (in 2024).

In these cases, the consent of the Federal Employment Agency is required.

Bring a print out of this checklist for your interview. All documents listed here are to be submitted in the requested **form and order**. DO NOT STAPLE.
