Visa for family reunion – Parent to minor German child

Basic information

- Please see basic information on applying for a visa on our website. **Applications can only be submitted via the [Consular Services Portal](#).**
- The German mission is only competent should you have your permanent residence in Tanzania
- Documents not in the German language must be submitted with a certified German translation. A translation of the personal data page of the passport is, however, not required.
- Certificates, diplomas, etc. must be presented in the original with apostille/legalization. Your original documents will be returned to you once your application has been processed.
- **Processing time is as a rule ca. six weeks** if complete but can take longer in individual cases.
- Flight reservations are not required to apply for a visa – please only book when you have received your visa.
- The mission abroad reserves the right to request further documents.
- Missing documentation delays the procedure and can result in your application being rejected.
- **Please do not contact the mission abroad to check the status of your application during the normal processing period.** Such inquiries are extremely time-consuming for the visa section and can thus not be answered.

General information

The German Mission reserves the right to ask for additional documentation at any time during the processing of the application whenever deemed necessary. Presenting the mentioned documentation does not guarantee that the visa will be granted. We strongly recommend that you do not purchase an airline ticket unless the visa has been approved and the German Mission requests you to do so.

The processing time can take up to three months. Once the application has been approved by the relevant German authority, the German Mission will issue a visa valid for 3 months. Your subsequent residence permit will be issued by the competent Aliens Authority in Germany. You are required to apply well in advance for it before the expiry of the visa.

Use the following checklist to make sure your application documents are complete and bring in a print out for your interview. All documents listed here are to be submitted in the requested **form and order**.

Visa application checklist	
The following documents are to be submitted in full with every application.	
<input type="checkbox"/>	One fully completed and signed applications including declarations pursuant to Section 54 Residence Act
<input type="checkbox"/>	Where applicable, one declaration fully completed and signed regarding contact details and power of attorney as well as
<input type="checkbox"/>	One recent biometric passport photo (see specimen photos)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Valid and personally signed passport with at least two completely empty pages
<input type="checkbox"/>	One uncertified Copy of the data page of your valid passport
<input type="checkbox"/>	Applicant's birth certificate
<input type="checkbox"/>	(certified copy of) Passport of German child and One Copy
<input type="checkbox"/>	Birth certificate of German child (either German birth certificate, legalized Tanzanian birth certificate or foreign certificate with Apostille/legalisation) or doctor's confirmation about the pregnancy
<input type="checkbox"/>	One copy of passport of child's German/other parent
<input type="checkbox"/>	Residence registration certificate of the German child/German parent (original) and information whether applicant will stay there <i>or alternatively/and</i> proof of accommodation with one copy
<input type="checkbox"/>	Acknowledgement of paternity as well as consent of mother as well as proof of custody or Tanzanian court order (by Juvenile Court) concerning parentage as well as proof of custody – or marriage certificate of parents (before child was born) Attention: Should it be a case of a pre-natal acknowledgement of paternity with the mother residing within Germany the acknowledgement of paternity is not yet valid. You may provide documents according to this information sheet but a different legal ground applies which entails that you need to provide proof of income and residence.
<input type="checkbox"/>	In case of -single - foreign mother – certificate of no impediment to marry/being single (at time of birth!)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Health insurance - either national health insurance or in line with EU standards (to cover taking up residence in Germany and valid for the entire Schengen area, minimum coverage of 30,000 €, valid from the day of entry for the entire stay)
<input type="checkbox"/>	In case of former marriage – divorce decree or death certificate from former spouse(s)
