## Information sheet: national visa

## Visa for vocational training (Section 16a Residence Act)

## **Basic information**

- Please see basic information on applying for a visa on our website. Applications can only be submitted via the <u>Consular Services Portal</u>.
- The German mission is only competent should you have your permanent residence in Tanzania
- Documents not in the German language must be submitted with a certified German translation. A
  translation of the personal data page of the passport is, however, not required.
- Certificates, diplomas, etc. must be presented in the original with apostille/legalisation
- As a rule, visa applications must be approved by the competent foreigners authority or the Federal Employment Agency in Germany. The visa can only be issued when this approval has been received.
- Processing time is as a rule ca. eight weeks but can take longer in individual cases.
- Flight reservations are not required to apply for a visa please only book when you have received your visa.
- The mission abroad reserves the right to request further documents.
- Missing documentation delays the procedure and can result in your application being rejected.
- Please do not contact the mission abroad to check the status of your application during the normal processing period. Such inquiries are extremely time-consuming for the visa section and can thus not be answered.

## **General information**

You can do vocational training in Germany if you have a training place in a company and German language skills (B1 for qualified vocational training). If you are less proficient in German, you can however also do a language course before starting your training.

	Applicant's birth certificate
	School reports as well as school leaving certificate and proof of recognition in Germany
	Training contract in German (where applicable recognised by the Chamber of Industry and
	Commerce) signed by the employer and the trainee (original). If stated in the deficit notification:
	registration for theoretical courses, in-company training measures (with further training plan) or
	exam preparation courses (original and one copy)
	One copy of the training plan
	Letter of motivation concerning profession and motivation
	CV
	Where not otherwise confirmed by the training centre:
	Proof of German language skills (at least B1 for qualified vocational training) or
	Proof of registration for a preparatory intensive language course
	Proof of adequate financial means
	<u>Financing</u>
	Proof of financing of at least 855,- € net (2025)/ 1.030,-€ gross (2025) per month for the first
	year. If an unpaid preparatory German language course is being completed or if the trainee wage
	is lower, provision of the monthly shortfall of funds must be proven separately, for example, in
	the form of a blocked account.
	Where applicable - in case of a preparatory language course:
	- Admission to the preparatory language course with at least 18 hours per week as well as
	-Proof of receipt of vocational training place if language skills are provided
	- A1 certificate. A submitted language certificate must have been issued by an ALTE-certified
	institution
	Proof that fees have been paid
	Where applicable, authorisation to take up employment issued by the Federal Employment
	Agency/Central Placement Office of the Federal Employment Agency (ZAV)

Note: German employers can apply for the authorisation needed for the visa application directly from the	
Federal Employment Agency/ZAV by presenting the training contract. If this authorisation is presented	
with the visa application, the visa section can process the application much more quickly.	
Please note in case of vocational training in the medical sector – including care – you will need to have	
to present the permit/proof on how the job placement took place, as due to issue of avoiding 'brain drain'	
restrictions do apply.	
☐ Proof of adequate health insurance cover	
If as a trainee you are subject to mandatory statutory health insurance, you must bear in mind	
that this insurance can only begin when you take up residence in Germany and begin your	
training. If you enter Germany beforehand, private health insurance must be taken out for the	
period prior to beginning your training and prior to being eligible for statutory health insurance.	
In its terms and conditions, travel health insurance can exclude protection if a long-term or	
permanent stay is planned. So-called incoming travel insurance can also contain such exclusions.
